On behalf of TFCU, I would like to thank you for your interest in our scholarship program. We will be awarding nine scholarships of \$1,000 each to students who are credit union members. Also, this year, we will award one person *The Charles Hart Memorial Scholarship* for \$2,000.

Scholarship applicants must be:

1. An account holder of TFCU.
2. A graduating high school senior or enrolled in an accredited university.
3. Accepted as a full-time student at a college or university, carrying 12 credit hours or more.

Please note: Applicants cannot be immediate family members of TFCU employees, Board of Directors or Supervisory Committee Members. *Applicants that have previously been awarded this scholarship are not eligible.*

Application Requirements are:

1. Submit your completed scholarship application.
2. Submit a current copy of your high school or college transcript. (Online transcripts will be accepted.)
3. Submit a 500-word narrative on the following topic: **At TFCU, we understand that attaining a higher education can be challenging for students and their families because of the financial burden that may come with this goal. As a credit union, the founding principle and philosophy of "People Helping People" is at the heart of our scholarship program. Please explain why you deserve this scholarship and what it would mean to you if selected?**
